Spending more time on the dance floor than sleeping or eating, Zoey danced & trained in Hip-Hop styles of many, 24 hours a day 7 days a week. In 2005 after moving back to Washington DC he had the opportunity of training and dancing with a very well known and long established dance organization called CULTURE SHOCK. As a scholarship dancer with CULTURE SHOCK DC, Zoey became familiar with the responsibilities and demands of dancing & training with a professional dance company. While dancing on his spare time, Zoey was employed full-time with an Acting/Modeling Company called John Robert Powers. Starting from the bottom of the ladder as office staff, Zoey quickly showed his abilities for leadership responsibilities. In 2007, after two years of hard work with the company, Zoey was moved to Las Vegas to be the new Directing Manager of a new opened John Robert Powers Las Vegas Franchise. To his blessing he quickly found family, friends and dance with CULTURE SHOCK LAS VEGAS as well as other dance troupes in the city. There he furthered his dancing training and experience traveling to different cities and performing with the troupe as well as creating his dance network with other mainstream dancers and troupes. Zoey has had the privilege of meeting as well as showcasing with and for other dance troupes such as the Jabbawockeez and Kaba Modern at Culture Shock Annual showcases San Diego and Takin' It To Da Streets Las Vegas; Working with choreographers such as Jesse Lee Santos, Jerry Slaughter, and NappyTabs who's credits include: Britney Spears, Christina Aguilera, Usher, Mariah Carey and the reality series on FOX 's So You Think You Can Dance, as well as MTV's America's Best Dance Crew. Constantly a student and challenging himself as a dancer, Zoey is tapping into other forms of dance such as lyrical and contemporary. Determined to making a mark as a main stream choreographer Zoey is climbing his way by booking travel workshops and choreography jobs in Los Angeles, Jacksonville, N. Carolina, Atlanta, Las Vegas, DC and teaching at surrounding studios in Los Angeles, dancing and showcasing for other choreographer projects such as 2009's Maxt Out Dance Showcase and directing his own new dance company "Soul Purpose." As a dancer and choreographer, Zoey also is a supporter to his dance colleagues in the business, taking their workshop, supporting events and connecting them with his line of networks.
